To the Honorable Mayor and City Council,

I am composing this letter in regards to fees I have received for a water bill shut off and restart for 25 American Ave. While I understand the need for such fees in regards to untimely payments, I have to dispute these charges. While I was certainly behind on my bill, I am aware of the process and always call to verify upon receiving a blue shut off notice. I have 2 houses in Keene and have had some financial issues in the past year. I always pay my bill prior to shut off. When my husband called me to tell me we had no water I was very upset as we had not received a notice. We were charged \$219.15 for the shut off and to turn our water back on. We went to our other home to get the mail about a week after this happened (we only check it 1 time a month) and we found the blue notice had been mailed to that address instead of our home address where the water was shut off. I am requesting that the city refund the charges I incurred for the error. I would have certainly paid the bill had I received it prior to the shut off. When you are struggling financial \$219.15 is a large amount of money and I could pay almost another whole water bill with this money.

I appreciate your time in reviewing this request.

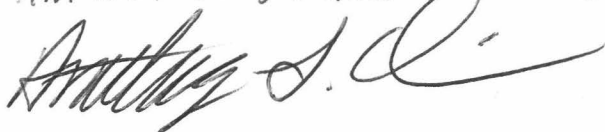

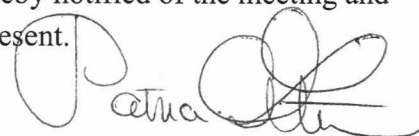

Dear Mayor and City Council,

My name is Eric Allen and I work for Mac's Market located at 501 Main Street in Keene, NH. I am writing today to ask that a "NO PARKING" sign be put on Sheridan Ave across from the dumpsters behind the Mac's Market building. The reason for the "NO PARKING" sign is because a neighbor, Keene Auto Body, is deliberately blocking the easement of both Mac's Market and Discount Oil of Keene, with a pick-up truck.

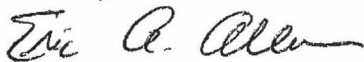
What is happening is this; when the waste truck comes to pick up the garbage, the truck uses the width of Sheridan Ave to properly position itself in order to use its front forks to pick up the waste dumpster and load its contents into the container of the waste truck. Because Keene Auto Body parks its truck directly in front, across the street, from the dumpster, the waste truck is unable to position itself to load the dumpster.

Moreover, we feel there is a potential safety hazard created by this situation because the Keene Auto Body truck could potentially block emergency vehicles from accessing either the fire hydrant on Sheridan Ave or one of the buildings on the corner of Main and Sheridan.

Furthermore, Lou Berube, owner of Discount Oil of Keene and I agree that both our transports cannot gain access to the yard through Sheridan Ave, where we share a right of way easement for large trucks to access both parties.
